

ORDINANCE NO. 1848

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ON STREET PARKING OF VEHICLES AND RESTRICT THE SPEED AT WHICH ANY PERSON SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON TALLADEGA COLLEGE CAMPUS ROADWAYS IN THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY TYE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Talladega College campus roadways consist of the following: Martin Luther King Jr. Drive from the intersection with Ft. Lashley Avenue to the intersection with Coosa Street West; all of Gertrude Street, all of Church Street; College Street from the intersection with Martin Luther King Jr. Drive to Church Street; Cruickshank Street from the intersection with Nolen (Nolan) Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Drive; Nolen (Nolan) Street from the intersection with Battle Street West to the intersection with College Street; and Battle Street West from the intersection with Ft. Lashley Avenue to the intersection with 26th Street.

SECTION 2. That on-street parking is prohibited on the roadways of the Talladega College campus.

SECTION 3. That it shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle to operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour on the Talladega College campus.

SECTION 4. That the Public Works Department for the City of Talladega shall erect on each side of said streets on the Talladega College campus appropriate signs indicating that the speed limit on said roadways is restricted to a speed of not greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour and that on-street parking is prohibited.

SECTION 5. That any person who shall be convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than One Hundred Eighty days (180), or both at the discretion of the Court trying the case.

SECTION 6. All sections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
