

ORDINANCE NO. 1857

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND RESTRICT THE SPEED AT WHICH ANY PERSON SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON LONG STREET, TO PROHIBIT ON STREET PARKING ON SAID STREET AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEROF. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle to operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Long Street from the intersection with West Battle Street to the intersection with Pulliam Street.

SECTION II: That it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on Long Street from the intersection with West Battle Street to the intersection with Pulliam Street. On-street parking is prohibited due to the narrowness of the roadway.

SECTION III: That the Public Works Director or designee shall erect or cause to be erected, on each side of Long Street an appropriate sign indicating that the speed limit on said road is restricted to speed not greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

SECTION IV: That any person who shall be convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One dollar (\$1.00), nor more than Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than One Hundred Eighty days (180), or both at the discretion of the court trying the case.

SECTION V: All section of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
