

ORDINANCE NO. 1685

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE A SECTION OF ALABAMA HIGHWAY 21 TO BE NAMED FORT LASHLEY AVENUE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: A section of Alabama Highway 21 is currently named Fort Lashley Avenue. This ordinance designates the boundaries of Fort Lashley Avenue along the Alabama Highway 21 within the city limits of the City of Talladega. Traveling north to south on Alabama Highway 21, Fort Lashley Avenue begins at the intersection of Battle Street West veering off to the right and Highway 21 continuing on to the left and ends at the intersection of Angus Street to the right and Bemiston Avenue to the left (Attachment A).

SECTION II: The Public Works Department or designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the name of the street. The City Clerk shall notify all pertinent governmental agencies of the name change.


SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.




