

ORDINANCE NO. 1686

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE TINNEY STREET SOUTH, TINNEY STREET NORTH AND LUMBER YARD ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The roadway that was originally known as Tinney Street has changed over the years with sections being closed along the railroad and other sections rerouted. The City of Talladega wishes to designate and name sections of this roadway as stated below and shown on the map titled Attachment A (map is available for viewing at the City Clerk's Office):

Tinney Street South – traveling south to north beginning at Ironaton Road and ending at Alabama Highway 21 (East Battle Street).

Tinney Street North – traveling south to north beginning at Alabama Highway 21 (further east from where Tinney Street South meets East Battle Street and turning left after crossing over the railroad bridge) and ending at the Brecon Access Road.

Lumber Yard Road – traveling south to north beginning on the northern side of East Battle Street across from the ending point of Tinney Street South and dead ends at the railroad tracks.

Previously this roadway was known as Tinney Street and crossed the railroad tracks to end at Brecon Access Road, but has now been closed to traffic on the southern side of the railroad tracks with access to Tinney Street North being rerouted further east from Alabama Highway 21.

SECTION II: The Public Works Department or designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the name of the street. The City Clerk shall notify all pertinent governmental agencies of the name change.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
