

ORDINANCE NO. 1701

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND RESTRICT THE SPEED AT WHICH ANY PERSON SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON ELM STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEROF. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle to operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour on Elm Street from its intersection with Cedar Street southerly to its intersection with McMillan Street East.

SECTION II: That the Chief of Police or his designee shall erect or cause to be erected, on each side of said Elm Street an appropriate sign indicating that the speed limit on said road is restricted to speed not greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour.

SECTION III: That any person who shall be convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One dollar (\$1.00), nor more than Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than One Hundred Eighty days (180), or both at the discretion of the court trying the case.

SECTION IV: All section of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
