

ORDINANCE NO. 1745

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE BEGINNING AND ENDING POINT OF A ROAD TO BE NAMED ALLEN STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: In order to ensure public safety and the ability of first responders to locate a citizen's address, the City Council wishes to partner with the Talladega County E-911 Office to officially designate a unique name for each roadway within the City limits and to dictate the beginning and ending points of such roadways, so that all government agencies will have the same information.

SECTION II: The City Council of the City of Talladega wishes to designate Allen Street beginning in the West at the three-way intersection of Ward Avenue, Thornton Street and Allen Street and continuing easterly and north easterly to the Alabama Highway 275 By-Pass (Attachment A).

SECTION II: The Public Works Department or designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the name of the street. The City Clerk shall notify all pertinent governmental agencies of the name change.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
