

ORDINANCE NO. 1746

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE BEGINNING AND ENDING POINT OF A ROAD TO BE NAMED ANGUS STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: In order to ensure public safety and the ability of first responders to locate a citizen's address, the City Council wishes to partner with the Talladega County E-911 Office to officially designate a unique name for each roadway within the City limits and to dictate the beginning and ending points of such roadways, so that all government agencies will have the same information.

SECTION II: The City Council of the City of Talladega wishes to designate Angus Street beginning in the West at the intersection with Alabama Highway 275 (Western By-Pass) and continuing easterly to where it dead ends in approximately 1275 feet. The City Council wishes to further designate a private drive beginning at approximately 830 feet east of the beginning point of Angus Road and heading north to be named Tumlin Lane (Attachment A).


SECTION II: The Public Works Department or designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the name of the roadways. The City Clerk shall notify all pertinent governmental agencies of the name change.


SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.


