

**ORDINANCE NO. 1770**

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THREE ROADWAYS IN THE BELLEVIEW SUBDIVISION (SCENIC DRIVE, ADAMS RIDGE LANE, AND LOOKOUT LANE) AS PUBLIC ROADWAYS TO BE MAINTAINED BY THE CITY OF TALLADEGA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: This ordinance designates the length of which the three roadways as follows: Scenic Drive with the beginning point at the intersection of Eastaboga Highway traveling west for approximately 2,335 ft. to an intersection with Adams Ridge Lane; Adams Ridge Lane beginning point at the intersection of Scenic Drive traveling north approximately 600 ft to a dead end; and Lookout Lane with the beginning point of Scenic Drive traveling north approximately 310 ft. to a dead end. All roadways are part of the Belleview Subdivision, 1<sup>st</sup> Addition, Section 1 approved by the Talladega Planning Commission on January 12, 1987 and recorded in Plat Book 006, Page 132 in the Judge of Probate's office on January 13, 1987.

SECTION II: All roadways designated in Section I of this ordinance shall be maintained by the City of Talladega. It is on the opinion of the City Attorney that the roadways within the Belleview Subdivision have been adopted and meet the subdivision regulation standards, and that the City has assumed responsibility for repairs based on a continual pattern of maintenance.

SECTION III: The Chief of Police, the Public Works Department or their designee shall erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the name of the streets, streets that are dead ends and the speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour. The City Clerk shall notify all pertinent governmental agencies of the street name designations.

SECTION IV: All sections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
