

ORDINANCE NO. 1850

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE BEGINNING AND ENDING POINTS OF ERA SCOTT CIRCLE AND STAPLES LANE; TO DESIGNATE SAID STREETS AS ONE WAY ONLY; TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON SAID STREETS; AND TO RESTRICT THE SPEED AT WHICH ANY PERSON SHALL OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON ERA SCOTT CIRCLE AND STAPLES LANE WITHIN THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Talladega wishes to designate Era Scott Circle as beginning at Martin Luther King Jr. Drive North continuing easterly to the intersection with Adams Avenue; and to designate Staples Lane (a previously unnamed alley) beginning at the intersection with Adams Street and continuing south to the intersection with McAlpine Street.

SECTION II: Era Scott Circle is designated as a one-way road beginning at the intersection with Martin Luther King Jr. Drive North and traveling easterly to the intersection with Adams Avenue. Furthermore, Staples Lane is designated a one-way road beginning at the intersection with Adams Avenue and traveling south to the intersection of McAlpine Street.

SECTION III: That it shall be unlawful for the driver or operator of any vehicle to operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour on Era Scott Circle and Staples Lane.

SECTION IV: That street parking of any vehicle shall be unlawful on Era Scott Circle and Staples Lane.

SECTION IV: That the Chief of Police, the Public Works Director or their designee shall erect or cause to be erected the necessary signs to indicate one-way direction of traffic and speed limits.

SECTION V: Any person who shall be convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar, nor more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in that jail wherein persons sentenced to imprisonment by the Municipal Court of the City of Talladega are imprisoned for not less than Ninety (90) days, or both at the discretion of the Court trying the case.

SECTION VI: All ordinances or parts of ordinances to conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII: All sections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION VIII: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as provided by law.
