

ORDINANCE NO. 1868

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 1249 AND TO ABOLISH THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION IN THE CITY TALLADEGA

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Talladega, Alabama, finds it to be in the best interest of the City of Talladega to repeal Ordinance No. 1249 and to abolish the Historic Preservation Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 1249 is hereby repealed and the Historic Preservation Commission is hereby abolished subject to said Commission winding up its affairs.

SECTION 2. That the Historic Preservation Commission shall forthwith deliver all of its books, records and accounts to the City Clerk of the City of Talladega.

SECTION 3. Upon adoption of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 1249 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its adoption and publication, as provided by law.
