Thank you for your interest in Heritage Hall Museum's 2009 Arts Camps for Kids. The museum and camp faculty are pleased to be able to offer this unique, intensive arts enrichment experience. We greatly appreciate your support of Arts Camps for Kids and anticipate this year's camps to be the best yet. The following information will help you and your child prepare for Arts Camp:

Where: Arts Camp will be held on The Alabama School for the Deaf campus located at 205 South Street East (across the street from Heritage Hall Museum). Your child will need to be taken to the Career Tech Complex located at the back of the campus and adjacent to the football stadium on the AID's Campus. From Cherry Street, turn onto Gulsby Drive (this road is between the last row of buildings and the football field), there will be an Arts Camp Staff member there to meet your child and get him/her signed in for the day. Please be aware that Gulsby Drive is a one way street and there is limited parking. You will pick your child up at the same location.

When: We have two camp sessions, June 8 – 12 and July 6 – 10. Classes will begin each morning at 8:00 a.m. and we will dismiss at 12:00 p.m. Your child may sign up for one session or both sessions.

What will we do: There will be four areas of instruction; drawing and painting, pottery and sculpture, music and theatre, and dance and creative movement.

Clothing: Comfort is the key word when deciding what to wear. Parents remember, your child will be painting and creating "masterpieces" in moist clay, so shorts, t-shirts and play shoes will be suitable. Please remind your child that their shoes must be worn at all times.

Snacks: Campers will have a mid morning break. You will need to send a snack and a drink from home.

How much does camp cost: Arts Camp tuition is \$100 per child per week. Heritage Hall Museum does however offer a special tuition discount to families with more than one child. The discounted rates are \$100 for the first child in the family per week and \$90 for each additional child in the same family per week.

Your child should not bring toys or other play items from home – there are plenty of activities planned to keep the children busy and having fun!
