

RESOLUTION NO. 1660

WHEREAS, the City of Talladega, Alabama, wishes to apply for a FY 2008 Community Development Block Grant funds to extend public sewer service to the residents of the Coleman Circle neighborhood, and,

WHEREAS, the hookup of residences to the sewer line is required as a part of this grant program, and,

WHEREAS, it is allowable under ADECA Policy Letter No. 9 Revision 1 and associated memorandums from the ADECA Director dated February 27, 2003 and May 9, 2003 to provide hookups for high income households, so long as the costs associated with said hookups come from the local cash match and not the CDBG funds, and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Talladega, Alabama, to designate such hookups as a "public purpose" to provide hookups to all occupied households in the specific project area, irrespective of income.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Talladega, Alabama, that these hookups of high income households on the Coleman Circle sewer extension are deemed to be for a stated public purpose, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City of Talladega, Alabama, that it understands and agrees that no CDBG funds will be expended in the connection of these high income households and that only households of low and moderate income residents will be connected using the grant funds.
