Brought before the Council was the discussion of a street closure for Halloween. City Manager Hill stated that the request was not for a road closure but for the parking lot of Griffin's and Subway for a fall festival. It was mentioned that the two businesses were requested to contact with surrounding business owners such as Stampede and Daily Grind concerning the closure of the parking lot. It was also requested that the Police Department aid in the traffic direction for pedestrians. Also requested was a waiver of business license fees and tax.
