

**CITY COUNCIL OF TALLADEGA
CITY COUNCIL CALLED MEETING
March 21, 2021 – 4:00 pm**

The City Council of the City of Talladega met in a called meeting on Monday, March 21, 2022 at 4:00 p.m., at the Talladega City Hall Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order and the following were present: Council President Horace Patterson, Councilman Joe Power, Council Member Betty Spratlin, Councilman Trae Williams, and City Manager Seddrick Hill.

Invocation by Council President Patterson.

Motion by Council Member Spratlin with a second from Councilman Williams to excuse the absence of Council Member Hall. AYES: All.

Council President Patterson deferred to City Manager Hill concerning the Capital Improvement Projects. City Manager Hill provided to the Council a list of incomplete CIP projects from the years 2018-2021. It was requested that some of the unspent funds be redirected for the creation of a greenspace. Councilman Power inquired if this could be completed by the end of the year. City Manager Hill commented that the City could try to. There was also some discussion concerning Willman Road. There was discussion concerning the items presented for the CIP for the FY 2022 to FY 2024. A completed budget and ordinance would be brought to the Council at a Council meeting for consideration.

Brought before the Council was a discussion concerning the ARPA funds. The recommended expenditure for the ARPA funds were for Public Health, Negative Economic Impacts, Services for Disproportionately Impacted Communities, Premium Pay, Infrastructure, Revenue Replacement, and Administrative. Council President Patterson stated that although he is in support of the ARPA funds, he would be abstaining from any votes concerning these funds.

Motion by Council Member Hall with a second from Councilman Williams for adjournment. AYES: All.
